Exchange applicants should demonstrate an intermediate level of English language ability equivalent to B1 on the Common European Framework of References for Languages (CEFR). B2 is expected for the students applying to the BA in Visual Culture, Bureau+ or any Postgraduate programme. NCAD does not offer English language classes, however support can be arranged for exchange students for essay writing if needed.
